### **Re: Your upcoming stay at Reflections Holiday Parks Wyangala Waters**

We would like to advise you that during your upcoming stay, the park will not have re-fuelling services available. Following an independent, expert review of our petrol supply systems due to non-compliance and safety issues, the advice was that we shut down the service immediately. As a result, the fuel service stations for a number of our inland parks were closed at the end of May this year. Safety of our guests, visitors and staff is our highest priority.

We ask that you fill your vehicle(s) before you arrive at the park and have provided a list of service stations closest to the park below.

For safety reasons, it is not permitted to store and decant your own fuel for vehicles and/or boats. We have installed a temporary fuel storage facility at the park to safely store guest' jerry cans. This facility has a limited capacity, so storage is on a first come, first serve basis.

Should you want to bring fuel into the park for storage, please call the park prior to your visit to confirm how much fuel you can bring and to check remaining storage availability. If you are bringing fuel, the jerry cans you utilise must not exceed a 20-litre capacity.



Boat owners may also bring in fuel that is within their boat tanks.

Secondary supply tanks with fully enclosed decanting systems, where they can be connected from the tank directly to the outboard motor is allowed.



The closure and replacement of fuel facilities is just one step in the group's inland park revitalisation program which provides a 10-year roadmap for the redevelopment and structure of these precious community assets.

We understand that the closure of the park's fuel supply system is inconvenient. We are currently working towards a design solution to replace the fuel facilities for the park and will be engaging a construction contractor in the coming months. Once design solutions have been decided on, we will be excited to share more about our new facilities and how the guest experience will be improved.

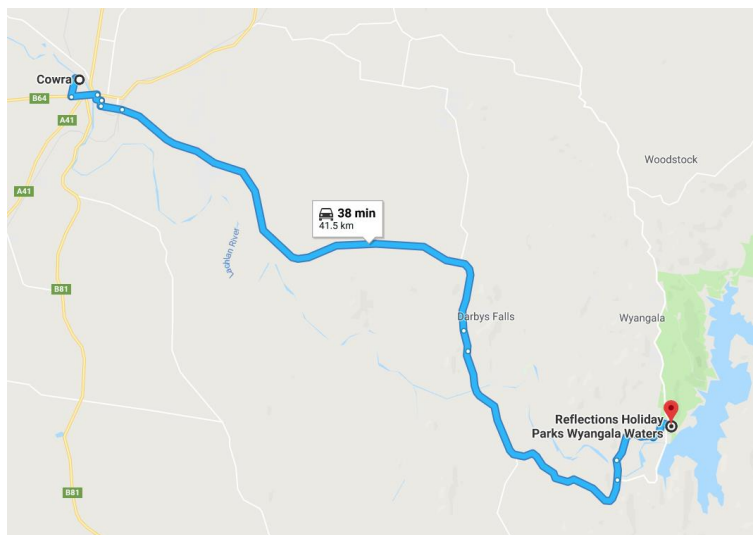
